



## Wolfenbüttel

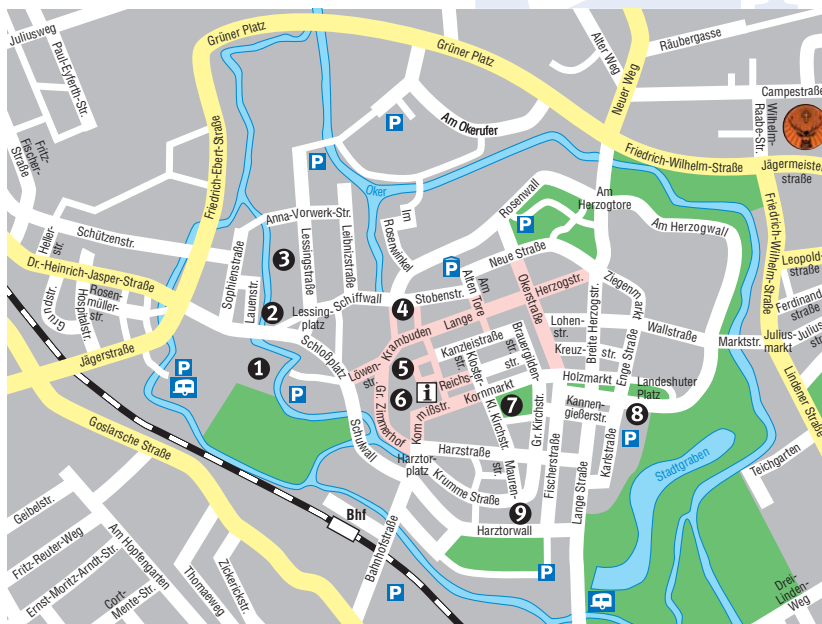
### Welcome to the residence of the Guelphs and the home of “Jägermeister”
